1. Health Check Items:
  - Blood Pressure and Heart Beat Reading
  - Cholesterol
  - Uric Acid
  - Urea
  - Glucose
  - S.G.P.T./ALT
  - S.G.O.T./AST
2. The above health check services will be carried out by the Hong Kong Federation of Trade Union Workers' Medical Clinics. Each participant will contribute a nominal fee of HK\$10 and HKCA will subsidize the remaining costs of this health check programme.
3. Each participant is eligible to one subsidized health check only. Further application will not be processed and the paid fee of HK\$10 will NOT be refunded.
4. The prime purpose of this Programme is for a general screening of personal health conditions of our construction workers, and is not intended for diagnosis or medical treatment. The Hong Kong Federation of Trade Union Workers' Medical Clinics will provide each participant with a test results report (complete both in Chinese and English) and a health assessment report (in Chinese only). These reports will be sent to the above mailing address provided by the participants within two weeks after the check. Nobody else will be given the reports.
5. Participants must be working on HKCA member company's construction sites and hold a valid construction workers registration card.
6. The Hong Kong Federation of Trade Union Workers' Medical Clinics crews will attend construction sites to carry out health checks and to take blood samples from workers on pre-agreed dates between 11:00 am-1:00 pm. The timetable will be publicized at each participating site entrance at the appropriate time.
7. The sponsor and/or the service providers will have the right to refuse any person to join this Programme.
8. Declaration for collection of personal data and information.

All personal data and information collected will be used solely for the purposes related to the HKCA Construction Workers Subsidised Health Check.
