### **HKCA Construction Safety Fund**

As our commitment on construction safety and to support new ideas and researches that facilitate and improve physical or behavioural safety practices throughout the supply chain, HKCA is pleased to announce the launch of the HKCA Construction Safety Fund. The Fund shall support ideas to improve construction safety with an initial seed funding of \$10 million.

Any individuals and industry stakeholders who wish to put into practice new safety initiatives to prevent fatalities, injuries and accidents on construction sites, new safety ideas, tools or equipment or methods to improve safety standards, practices and know-how on construction sites are welcome to make their applications.

The success of the Fund depends on the quality and dynamics of the ideas in attaining the desired results. We look for thoughtful practical suggestions and innovative ideas to enhance site safety. Collaboration programmes with HKCA that meet the objectives of the Fund are also welcome.

### **About the Construction Safety Fund (CSF)**

---

The CSF is set up in March 2018 by HKCA to provide financial incentives to contractors and industry stakeholders to develop and implement measures to prevent fatalities, injuries and accidents on construction sites. This is a commitment of HKCA to support construction safety initiatives and the initial seed funding is \$10 million.

Apart from statutory requirements, institutional obligations, professional conduct and ethics of construction safety which many contractors and stakeholders are now opting to practice as norm in their daily activities, the CSF primarily aims to encourage and support more new ideas and researches that can facilitate and improve physical or behavioural safety practices.

The CSF will also provide incentives and funding support to help workers raise personal safety awareness level, to proactively stop at sight and report safety hazards and/or unsafe working, change engrained adverse trade practices and behaviours or implementation of conducive environment for workers to work safely.

The CSF shall be administered by the Construction Safety Fund Committee to vet all relevant applications and decide on allocation of projects funding.

### **Principles of making Grants**

---

The CSF invites applications for Grant from all industry stakeholders on any practicable & innovative construction safety initiatives and researches. Collaboration programmes between HKCA and the applicants that meet the objectives of the CSF are also invited.

The normal Grant shall be up to HK\$250,000 for project duration that is less than 1 year. Higher amount may be given if the proposal and scope justify.

Grant applications shall be submitted with skeleton details of the ideal proposal including the nature and description of the project, applicant(s), administering institution(s) if any, amount, duration and deliverables. The applicants shall permit HKCA to make public the final reports / deliverables and promote the use of those "measures" widely on sites upon completion of the projects.

### 「建造業安全基金」簡介

---

香港建造商會「建造業安全基金」(基金) 於 2018 年 3 月成立，旨在提供經濟誘因，鼓勵承建商及行業持份者制定及採用新安全措施，以防止工地意外及傷亡事故。這是實踐商會對建造業安全許下的承諾；啟動資金為 1,000 萬元。

除法定要求外，不少承建商和持份者已恆常在其日常工作中採取工地安全應有的義務、專業操守和守則，而基金主要目的是鼓勵和支持更多新思維及研究，以改善安全行為和作業模式。

此外，基金也可提供誘因，幫助工友們提升個人安全意識水平、自覺地主動觀察和報告安全風險及/或不安全工作情況、改變頑固不良的工作行為操守，或實施有利於工人安全的工作環境。

基金將由建造業安全基金委員會負責督導、統籌和審核所有相關申請及決定資助項目的資金分配。

### 發放原則

---

「建造業安全基金」邀請所有行業持份者，就任何可行及創新的工地安全措施和研究提交申請資助；亦歡迎申請者提出切合基金目標並與商會聯手推行的合作計劃。

資助項目期限少於 1 年，一般金額可高達 25 萬元。如項目建議和內容合適，可獲更高的資助額。

申請者須提交建議的框架連同細節，包括資助項目的性質及內容、申請人、管理機構（如有）、項目金額、期限和成果的詳細描述。申請人須同意交由香港建造商會在該項目完成後，公開報告內容及成果，並廣泛推廣供工地採用其建議。
