Mandatory Basic Safety Training Course (Construction Work) and

New Examination Arrangements

We notice that some course participants of different ethnicities attending the **Mandatory Basic Safety Training Course (Construction Work)** and the **Mandatory Basic Safety Training Revalidation Course (Construction Work)** do not have good command of written/ spoken Chinese or English. Currently, they bring along an interpreter to assist their participation in class and examination. To enhance the learning experience of these participants, the Labour Department will implement new examination arrangements.

Starting from 28 February 2019, examination papers in six different languages (Urdu, Indonesian, Hindi, Thai, Nepali and Tagalog) will be provided for course participants of different ethnicities to facilitate their participation in examination without the company of the interpreter. Audio sound tracks of the examination questions in their languages will be available upon request. Interpreters can continue to accompany these course participants at other times during the course, including during the class, to provide translation/ interpretation.
