Briefing on A Study of the Risk Sharing Pattern in the Construction Projects in Hong Kong

This briefing aims to present a research study on exploring the common features of risk allocation in Hong Kong private construction contracts and categorize the type of inappropriate or unfair risk sharing pattern. Dr Andy Wong and Dr Johnny Wong, Department of Building and Real Estate, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University are the researchers for the report. Dr Andy Wong will discuss 7 major points of unfair risk sharing pattern are categorized, respectively, i) discrepancy of contract documents, ii) claim for extension of time, iii) claim for loss and/or expense, iv) rectification of defects, v) determination, omission and recovery by the employer, vi) unforeseeable ground conditions and vii) impending legislation. In addition, the concerns on BQ roles, warranty and bond issues are also addressed.

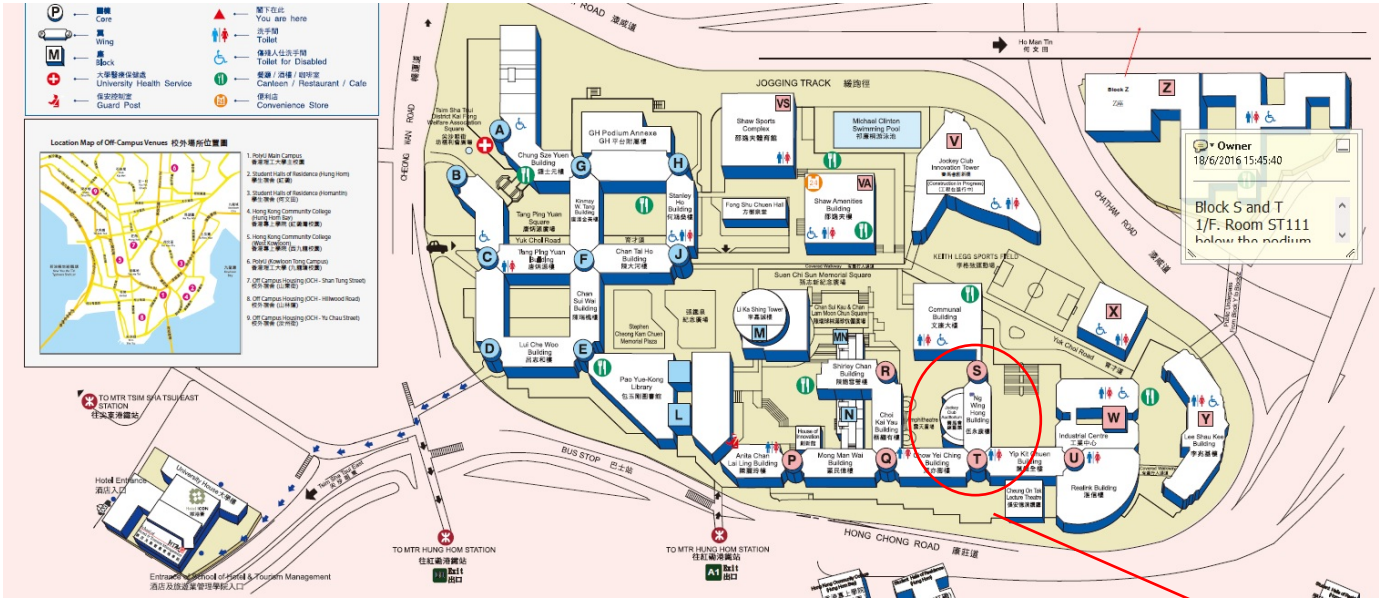
