Briefing on “Why and how will the Competition Ordinance influence the Hong Kong construction sector?”

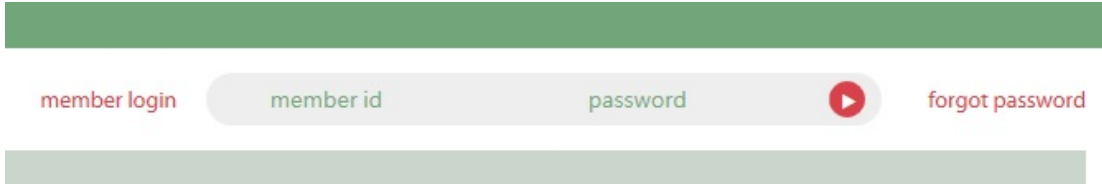

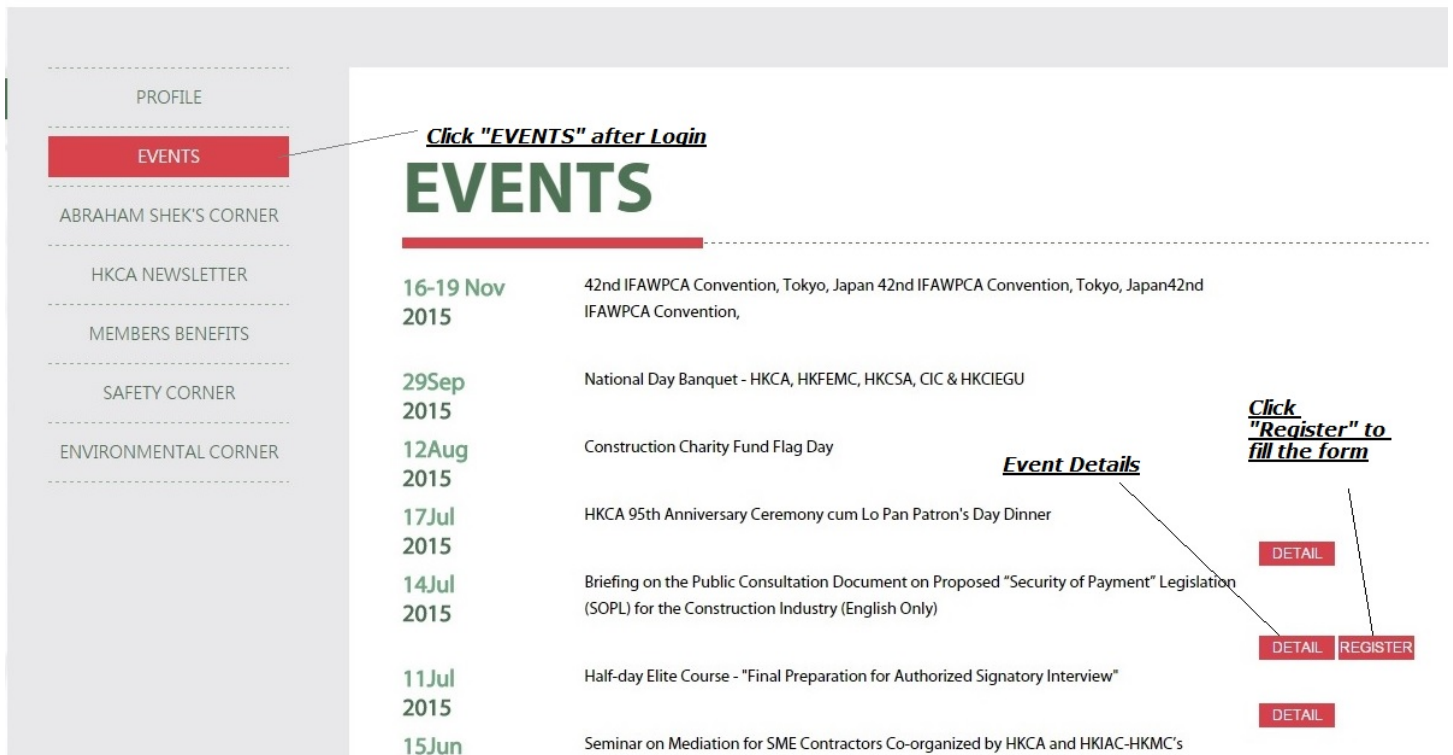
